A Guide for Daily Meditation and Prayer
Twenty-fifth Sunday after Pentecost – November 12-18, 2018

Pray and confess out loud as much as you are able, or as your family size and ages dictate. Learn by heart the verse, catechism, and hymn of the week.

Verse: 2 Corinthians 8:9

Alleluia. You know the grace of our Lord Jesus Christ, that though he was rich, yet for your sake he became poor, so that you by his poverty might become rich. Alleluia.

The Catechism: As the head of the family should teach in a simple way to his household:

In the same way also He took the cup after supper, and when He had given thanks, He gave it to them, saying, "Drink of it, all of you; this cup is the new testament in My blood, which is shed for you for the forgiveness of sins. This do, as often as you drink it, in remembrance of Me."
