Pray and confess out loud as much as you are able, or as your family size and ages dictate. Learn by heart the verse, catechism, and hymn of the week.

Verse: Matthew 2:2b
Alleluia. Where is he who has been born king of the Jews? For we saw his star when it rose and have come to worship him. **Alleluia.**

The Catechism: As the head of the family should teach in a simple way to his household:

The Ten Commandments - Sixth Commandment
What is the Sixth Commandment? You shall not commit adultery.
What does this mean? We should fear and love God so that we lead a sexually pure and decent life in what we say and do, and husband and wife love and honor each other.
