A Guide for Daily Meditation and Prayer  
Third Sunday of Easter – May 6-12, 2019

Pray and confess out loud as much as you are able, or as your family size and ages dictate. Learn by heart the verse, catechism, and hymn of the week.

**Verse:** Romans 6:9; Luke 24:32

**Alleluia.** We know that Christ being raised from the dead will never die again; death no longer has dominion over him. Alleluia. Did not our hearts burn within us while he talked to us on the road, while he opened to us the Scriptures? Alleluia.

**The Catechism:** As the head of the family should teach in a simple way to his household:

<b>The Lord's Prayer - The Conclusion</b> For thine is the kingdom and the power and the glory forever and ever. Amen.
<b>What does this mean?</b> This means that I should be certain that these petitions are pleasing to our Father in heaven, and are heard by Him; for he Himself has commanded us to pray in this way and has promised to hear us. Amen, amen means "Yes, yes, it shall be so."
